The team ministered to over 300 people! 100 people were born again and there were 26 recorded healings. As partners of Palomares Ministries, we purchased the raw materials so that our team could make over 400 cement blocks which will be used to continue building a church

Bill and Tammy Woods were our wonderful hosts and founders and directors of El Faro de Esperanza/Lighthouse of Hope Orphanage. The team stayed at the orphanage where some of our students assisted the staff in the school and kitchen caring for the 34 children who call Lighthouse of Hope their family and home! Alex and other team members worked at the ministry's nearby ranch where they learned to make

the cement blocks! The team also had the opportunity to do an outreach, minister at a youth meeting and led a Sunday morning church service.
