## A Major Milestone for CBC Mexico

On March 10, 2015, six second year CBC MX students, Alex and I set out on a supernatural adventure to the neighboring country of Belize. Most of the students on this team could not have imagined that they would be able to do something like this when they first enrolled in Charis Bible College México three years ago! The first time we made the announcement about fulfilling the mission trip requirement, most of the students looked back at us in disbelief wondering how they would ever be able to achieve this. One student even joked that we might end up with the enough funds to be able to go to “El Pueblito” which is an area on the northwest side of Querétaro (where we all live)! Well, let’s just say, that this ministry trip was not “within the realm of their possibilities” as is commonly said here in Mexico referring to one’s ability to do or have something. But, thank God! Not only did the students have the faith to raise funds, but finances began to come in from many unexpected sources. Students who had never held a passport before took that step. Another student, who had always been afraid of ministering overseas, confronted her fear. Several others overcame the unbelief of friends and family who questioned why would God send them to Belize. In the midst of all this, and their regular course work, they also spent many hours preparing testimonies, dramas, songs, teachings, gathering school supplies and props. When all the ingredients of this miracle came together during our week in Belize, the results certainly exceeded everyone's expectations... **We ministered to 500 children and teenagers! 37 people received Jesus as their Savior, 8 received the baptism in the Holy Spirit and 34 received healing! We ministered at a men's halfway house, a youth group and in a hospital. We also prayed for people house to house, painted a school and ministered in 2 churches!**
